



## 2006 HISTORIC PARIS DOWNTOWN WALKING TOURS

When Paris, Tennessee was settled, it was wild country. They said that when a baby cried in the night, the panthers would answer.

The 90-minute tour begins at the northwest corner of the square, home of Jack Jones Flowers, Jack's Java and Jack's Corner Books. It takes you to the courthouse lawn where battalions mustered for the Civil War, winds you by the cemetery where famous Parisians rest, past the Heritage Center and other historic homes on North Poplar, then back by the old depot and the Crete Opera House.
